Moto Men Jack Weaver and Happy Jack McMillan brought the boat tail 250 Bultaco that was personally signed by the first American ~ Jimmy Pomeroy. A classic 1970 Penton 125 MXer shined the stage and Weavers debut of his 1979 Fox Honda was so shiny you needed shades to view it! Also on hand was Gary Bailey to help out and sign a few autographs at the display. His 1969 Greeves was there to share a little history. It's interesting to note that it was a Greeves that Gary won on at that famous 4th of July Firecracker International Motocross event in 1969 beating the Europeans on US soil!

The Boyesen Link 1986 RM 250 that Bob Hannah won the Unadilla USGP was on display too. This bike generates a lot of interest every where it goes. It's a cool story on how the link was developed and that Bob actually turned faster lap times that day at Dilla on the bike. The Link suspension continued to be developed and raced by champs like Billy Liles. The Boyesen Team has been a big supporter of the tour and we would like to thank them for their contribution to the project.
